Improve the safe use of gloves

Frequent handwashing is one of the best ways to eliminate germs, avoid getting sick, and prevent the spread of germs to others. As workers likely encounter external substances on the jobsite, it is important to continue good hand hygiene by regularly washing their gloves. This extends the glove's longevity and helps control the spread of harmful substances.

Machine Washing Instructions with household laundry detergent

Glove Type	Wash	Rinse	Dry
Knit & Coated Cut Resistant	Warm (140°F / 60°C)	Cold	Tumble low (131°F / 55°C) or air dry to prevent shrinkage
Knit & Coated General Purpose	Warm (140°F / 60°C)	Cold	Tumble low (131°F / 55°C) or air dry to prevent shrinkage
Synthetic Leather	Warm (140°F / 60°C)	Cold	Tumble low (131°F / 55°C) or air dry to prevent shrinkage
Winter Insulated	Warm (140°F / 60°C)	Cold	Air dry
Leather	Warm (140°F / 60°C)	Cold	Air dry
Knit cut resistant without palm coating used in the food processing industry	Hot (203°F / 95°C)	Cold	Tumble (140°F / 60°C)
